Launch of 74 Sets of New Electric Vehicles (EV) Medium Chargers Under Phase 1 Enhancement Work for EV Charging Facilities

We are pleased to announce that Phase 1 Enhancement Work for Electric Vehicles (EV) Charging Facilities has been successfully completed. As part of this phase, 74 sets of EV medium chargers have been installed across various staff quarters and car park building on campus. These new EV medium chargers will be available for free use by HKUST staff who are the registered EV carpark permit holders with effect from 15 July 2024. Following the enhancement work of the EV charging facilities, a fee for EV charging will be introduced in the future.

The addition of these new EV chargers has significantly expanded the portfolio of EV charging facilities on our campus to meet the growing demand for EV charging. The available charging facilities now span standard, medium and fast chargers as summarized below to cater for diverse needs of campus users. Type of EV Charger	Quantity (as of July 2024)
EV Standard Charger (13A Socket Outlet)	11
EV Medium Charger (7kW)	84
EV Fast Charger (30kW and 60kW)	4
