Revised Operation of Lift 13-15 effective from 9 Sept 2024 (Monday)

It has been observed that the traffic of Lifts 13 to 15 is particularly busy going from LG1/F to 7/F during office hours. To optimize the performance of this group of lifts in handling the traffic demand and shorten passengers' waiting time, CMO will revise the lift operation as follows, **effective from 9 Sept 2024 (Monday)**.

Lifts serve all floors between LG5/F and 7/F without restriction.
15	Lifts serve all floors between LG7/F and 7/F. (LG7/F, LG5/F, LG4/F, LG3/F, LG1/F, G/F, 1/F, 2/F, 3/F, 4/F, 5/F, 6/F and 7/F)	Operation of Lift 15 remains unchanged , which will continue to serve all floors between LG7/F and 7/F without restriction.	

The new arrangement aims to reduce the travelling and waiting time of Lifts 13 & 14 during rush hours for passengers going between LG1/F and 7/F while Lift 15 will continue to serve all floors between LG7/F and 7/F.

After implementing the new lift operation mode, CMO will closely monitor and evaluate the lift performance to determine if any further improvements are necessary.
