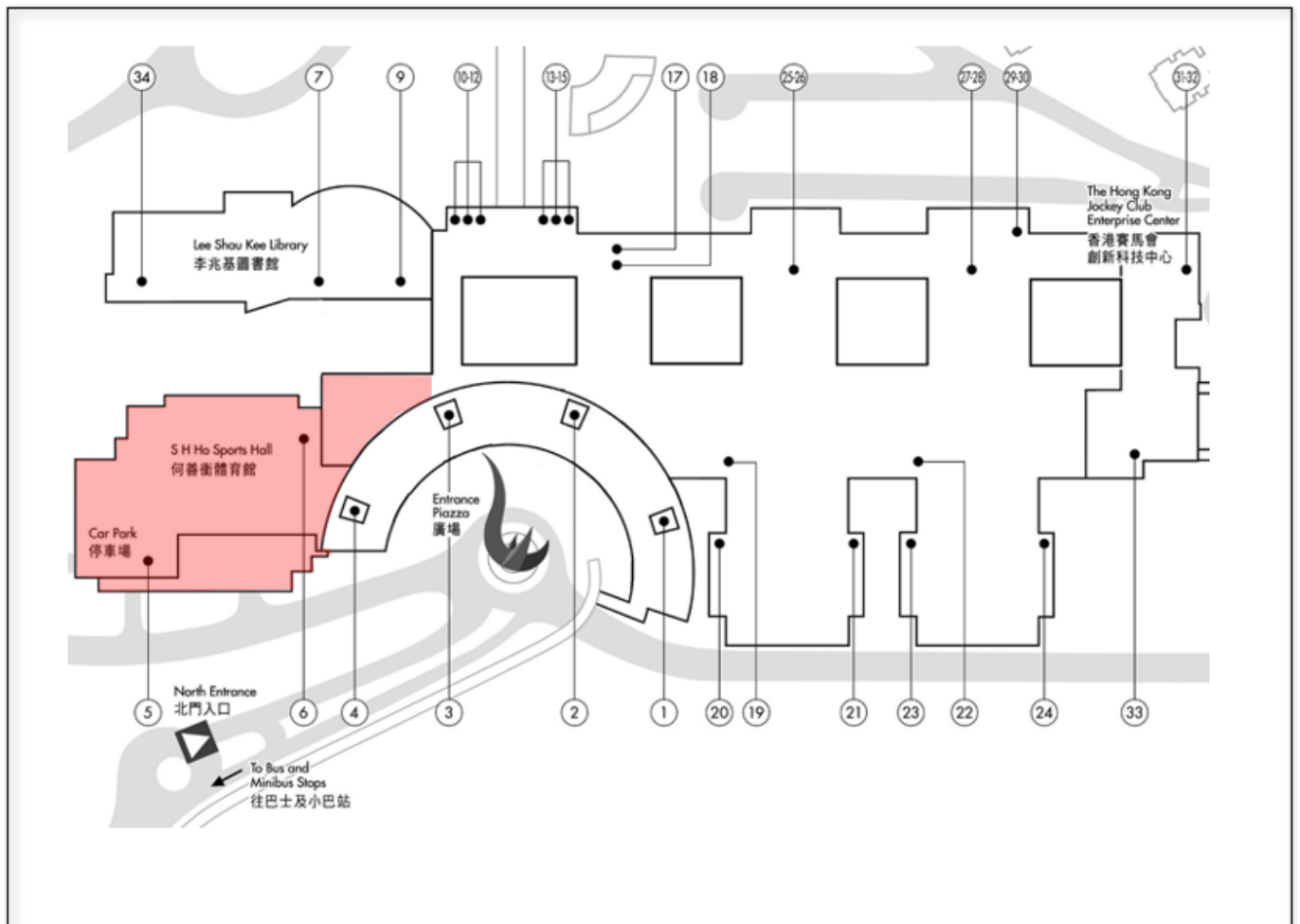




Suspension of Electricity Supply to Car Park Building and SH Ho Sports Hall on 9 February 2025 for Periodic Testing and Inspection of Electrical Installations (WR2)

Dear Members of HKUST,

We would like to notify you that CMO will be conducting a mandatory 5-year periodic inspection and testing of electrical installations, known as WR2, from 9am to 5:30pm on 9 February 2025, Sunday. This inspection will take place at Car Park Building and SH Ho Sports Hall as indicated on the plan below. The purpose of this electrical inspection and testing is to ensure the safety and reliability of the electricity supply on our campus, in compliance with the requirements of the Electricity Ordinance (Chapter 406).



As a result of power suspension, there will be temporary interruptions in certain facilities within the testing buildings during the testing period. The affected facilities are summarized as follows.

(Door may become unlocked during power outage, and therefore the affected departments/offices are advised to use mechanical keys or additional locks to secure the doors where necessary ahead of the power suspension) 3) Internet, network equipment, Wi-Fi access and computer workstations 4) Lifts 5 and 6 5) Electric vehicle charging stations 6) Car parking security systems, including gate payment machine and vehicle access control.

Special Attentions:

- (a) If you have equipment and appliances such as computers, office equipment, security system, network services, electrical appliances, sensitive electronic devices, medical equipment, or aquariums that may be vulnerable to the power interruption, please switch them off and disconnect them from the power supply if necessary during the testing period.
- (b) ****Food safety****: Please take precautions before, during, and after the power outage.
- (c) Please check all critical equipment connected to the temporary supply, and arrange for standby personnel if needed during the power suspension.
- (d) During the power outage, the auto-locks and electric locks on doors and rooms will be deactivated, meaning the doors will be unlocked. It is recommended that all affected offices secure their doors (main, front, and back) using mechanical keys and additional locks before leaving for the weekend.
- (e) For safety and security reasons, staff, faculty, students and visitors are advised not to enter or remain in the affected areas, except for authorized personnel or in emergencies.
