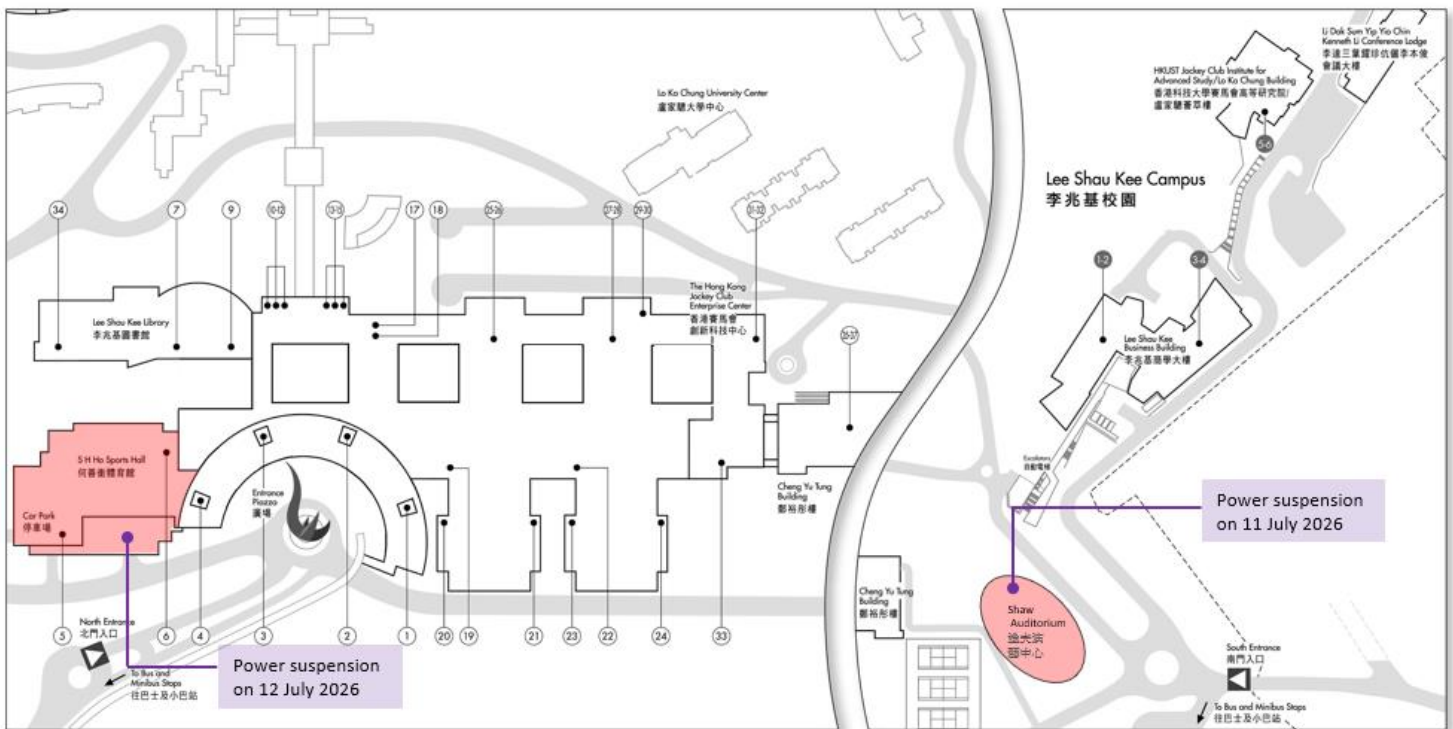




Temporary Suspension of Electricity Supply to Shaw Auditorium (11 July 2026, from 9am to 8pm) and Carpark Building & S H Ho Sports Hall (12 July 2026, from 9am to 6pm)

We would like to inform you that the electricity supply to the following buildings will be temporarily suspended, as indicated on the plan below.

- Shaw Auditorium: from 9:00am to 8:00pm on 11 July 2026 (Saturday)
- Carpark Building and S H Ho Sports Hall: from 8:00am to 6:00pm on 12 July 2026 (Sunday)



The temporary power suspension is required to facilitate the power upgrading work and 5-year periodic testing and inspection of electrical installations (commonly known as WR2). These measures are carried out to ensure the safety and reliability of the campus electricity supply, in compliance with the requirements of the Electricity Ordinance (Chapter 406). As a result of power suspension, there will be temporary interruptions to certain facilities within the affected buildings during the testing period. A summary of the impacted facilities is provided below.

Door may become unlocked during power outage, and we recommend that affect departments/offices use mechanical keys or additional locks to secure the doors where necessary before the test c) Internet, network equipment, Wi-Fi access and computer workstations. d) Footpath and carriageway lighting e) Learning and function rooms f) Main theatre and stage areas' relevant facilities and equipment, such as central control console, media server, digital dimmers, amplifiers, display system, PA system, projectors, lighting and sound systems, etc. g) Catering outlet "HFT Life" h) No lift services (Lifts 1, 2 and 3)
12 July 2026 (Sunday)	9am to 6pm	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> a) Carpark Building b) S H Ho Sports Hall c) Research postgraduate student hub rooms and student amenities rooms on LG4 (near Lift 3) d) Hair salon on LG1 e) Medical and dental clinics on LG1 (Interruption of air-conditioning supply only) f) Lee Shau Kee Library (No essential power supply only. The normal power supply and major facilities will not be affected during the testing and inspection period) 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> a) All lightings (both normal and essential), power sockets, refrigerators, air-conditioning, mechanical ventilation, CCTV surveillance, security system, and TV broadcasting system b) Auto-doors and e-locks control system. (Door may become unlocked during power outage, and therefore the affected departments/offices are advised to use mechanical keys or additional locks to secure the doors where necessary ahead of the power suspension) c) Internet, network equipment, Wi-Fi access and computer workstations d) No lift services (Lifts 5 and 6) e) Electric vehicle charging stations f) Carpark security system, including gate payment machine and vehicle access control.
<p>Special Attentions:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (1) If you have equipment and appliances such as computers, office equipment, security system, network services, electrical appliances, sensitive electronic devices, medical equipment, or aquariums that may be vulnerable to the power interruption, please switch them off and disconnect them from the power supply if necessary during the testing period. (2) **Food safety**: Please take precautions before, during, and after the power outage. (3) Please check all critical equipment connected to the temporary supply, and arrange for standby personnel if needed during the power suspension. (4) During the power outage, the auto-locks and electric locks on doors and rooms will be deactivated, meaning the doors will be unlocked. It is recommended that all affected offices secure their doors (main, front, and back) using mechanical keys and additional locks before leaving for the weekend. (5) For safety and security reasons, staff, faculty, students and visitors are advised not to enter or remain in the affected areas, except for authorized personnel or in emergencies. 			

To ensure an uninterrupted operation of critical facilities and equipment, CMO will collaborate with the affected end users to provide temporary backup power, if necessary, to main acceptable operating levels during this period.
